SUNDAY, May 26-Acro Classes & make-up pics

All students are encouraged to participate in PWDA Picture Day on *Sunday, April 21, 2024*. We would like students to participate in their class photos, even if you choose not to order any pictures!

- 1. Arrive at least 15 minutes before scheduled class appointment time. Please be on time.
- 2. Arrive in costume, with hair styled and light make-up applied. If you have several class pictures, then arrive prepared for your first class picture. Bring make-up, hair pins, hair spray, etc., for touch ups. *Younger dancers do not need to wear make-up*.
- 3. Studio A will be designated as the dressing room area for multiple costume changes. If you have more than one costume, please remember to bring your costumes and accessories, labeled with your student's name. All costume changes must be quick and efficient, so that we can stay on schedule.
- 4. BE PREPARED with appropriate color/style of tights*, shoes, hair pieces, accessories. Consider this a dress rehearsal before the real dress rehearsal!
- 5. No parents will be allowed to observe in studio B during photo session. Also, no personal photography in Studio B during our photo session with the photographer. We also request that siblings, brothers, friends, boyfriends, etc. not attend picture day as the girls will need privacy for quick costume changes, and space will be at a premium. The bathroom upstairs will be designated as the Boys dressing room.
- 6. Face Make-up for Picture Day: Everyday casual, or minimal.
- 7. Photographer will take both a class picture and individual picture of your child.

Important Tips for a successful Picture Day/Dress Rehearsal/Recital

- Wear assigned COLOR OF TIGHTS* & SHOES for each of your dances
- Tights should not have runs, holes, snags, etc, and should be the appropriate/designated color. *PWDA has tights in stock and available for sale. If you need to purchase tights, purchase them before PICTURE DAY.
- Students do not wear underwear with tights/costumes for pictures, or onstage for dress rehearsal or recital.
- Label all dance shoes with your child's name (INCONSPICUOSLY).
- "STAGE MAKE-UP" FOR DRESS REHEARSAL/RECITAL Dancers need to wear make-up on stage. Stage lighting diminishes and washes out facial color or blurs facial features. Foundation make-up helps to even out the skin tone, especially under lighting.
- Children age 3-8 years: Eyeshadow & eye liner not necessary. Lipstick, rouge and light mascara are recommended LIPSTICK: RECOMMENDED-MAYBELLINE SUPERSTAY MATTE INK LIPCOLOR #118/ DANCER
 EYE SHADOW-USE BROWN/NEUTRAL TONE SHADOW; NO HEAVY BLUE OR GLITTER EYESHADOW;
 CHEEKS-AVOID ROUGE WITH ORANGE UNDERTONES; BLUE UNDERTONES BEST(DARK ROSE, RED)
 MASCARA-HELPS EYES LOOK BIGGER/OPEN

EYELINER-CAN BE USED BY OLDER STUDENTS

LIP LINERS-CAN HELP DEFINE THE LIPS AND KEEP LIPSTICK FROM BLEEDING OR SMEARING.
